- F. It's been a long time since we had an 1876 Winchester. Manufactured in 1882. 143 years old! No caliber marked on the rifle. Internet research indicates that when no caliber is marked it was a 45-75 caliber. Since they were only manufactured in one caliber during this serial number time frame, there was no reason to mark the barrel. That being said, it is just internet research. You must have your gunsmith confirm the 45-75 caliber.
